

**Electoral Board Meeting  
12 July 2016**

The Electoral Board (EB) Meeting was called to order at 10:32 a.m. on July 12, 2016 with the following in attendance: Mary Truman, Secretary, Wally Sayko, Chairman, Barbara Lassiter, Vice- Chairman.

**Old Business:**

**New Business:**

Board discussed plans for training of poll workers. David and Mary will check in to where to hold training if conference room downstairs is not adequate. The room has an odor due to leaking plumbing.

Each Board member will talk with chiefs in their area about their needs and concerns for November election.

Mary will talk with Totaro, Sturgeon, Edgerton, and Fitzhugh. Barbara will talk with Danieltown, Alberta, Red Oak, King's Store. Wally will talk with Tillman, Rock Store, Dromgoole, Brodnax, and Seymour.

Board discussed what was new at annual conference. Emphasis was put on large turnout in November. Board discussed hiring a greeter for all precincts that will talk with voters in line and let them know what ID's were acceptable and to hand out pamphlets for amendments that are on the ballot. Hoping this will speed up the check in process.

Board had some concerns in regards to how to handle the end of the line situation when polls close. Board also discussed the possibility of having Brian Roberts, sheriff come and talk with all workers at big training and discuss how to handle the situation if voters bring guns in the precinct.
