

**Electoral Board Meeting
2 August 2019**

The Electoral Board (EB) Meeting was called to order at 9:42 a.m. on August 2, 2019 with the following in attendance: Mary Truman, Secretary, Barbara Lassiter, Vice-Chairman, Wally Sayko, Chairman, David Clary, Registrar

The agenda was approved. The minutes from July 12, 2019 were approved.

General Registrar Update:

David informed the Board that candidates for the November election had submitted all of their petitions. The only candidate that did not have enough signatures was Timothy Puryear so he will be running as a write in.

David informed the Board that all ballot information had been turned in to Kimberly at ESO and ballots should be printed soon.

Old Business:

The Board continued to discuss the problems with obtaining poll workers. Wally will work with Sylvia to put an ad in newspaper in the hopes of hiring more workers. Mary will contact Selene Montgomery to see if the Democratic Party has any potential workers and Wally will contact Erik Brazil, president of the local Republican Party.

The Board discussed the response they received from the letters sent to the Chiefs in May regarding them being in charge of their own precinct workers. We received an excellent response and most precincts' staffing will be handled by the Chiefs.

The Board continued to discuss the Alberta precinct. No decision was made on how to handle a better flow in the precinct between Alberta and King's Store.

New Business:

The Board decided to divide up the precincts amongst the Board members. Wally will handle Dromgoole, Tillman, Brodnax, Seymour, and Rock Store. Barbara will handle Danielstown, Elmore, Alberta, and King's Store. Mary will handle Totaro, Sturgeon, Edgerton, and Fitzhugh. Each Board member will be responsible for making sure that their precincts are staffed and ready for elections.

The Board discussed having one training meeting for chiefs and one training meeting for all other workers. The Board feels that by separating the trainings that they can focus more on what issues pertain to each group and will have a better training session.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:47 a.m.
